Lancaster County Carriage & Antique Auction is a live auction event held under several open-air tents in the Lancaster County countryside.

Each year, our team of 400+ volunteers and 20+ auctioneers transform our quiet country fields into a bustling marketplace that features 460 consignors and 4,000 event-goers from 27 states and 3 countries!

Proceeds from the auction benefit the Hand-in-Hand Fire Company, the volunteer fire company serving Bird-in-Hand, PA.

NEW FOR 2026!

Welcome to another great year of Lancaster County Carriage & Antique Auction! After 25 years of tremendous support and repeat consignments, our processes and communications leading up to the event will look a little different this year. **There will be no pre-consignments or pre-consignment catalog mailed this year.** This will enable us to decrease costs and use volunteer time more wisely; both of which will maximize proceeds for the Fire Company.

Instead, we will be posting during Auction week as items come in. **Consignments are still wanted**, so start your spring cleaning and plan to consign with us! Most* consigning will take place during the week of the sale only. Just come by during our Drop Off Days: Tuesday, June 23 - Thursday, June 25, and our team will be ready to help. See page 6 inside for more details, including drop-off times each day. **Mini Horses and Quilts are the only categories that have an earlier consignment deadline.*

There is no change to the bidding process, so spread the word and come to bid and buy during 2026 Auction days, June 25th and 26th!

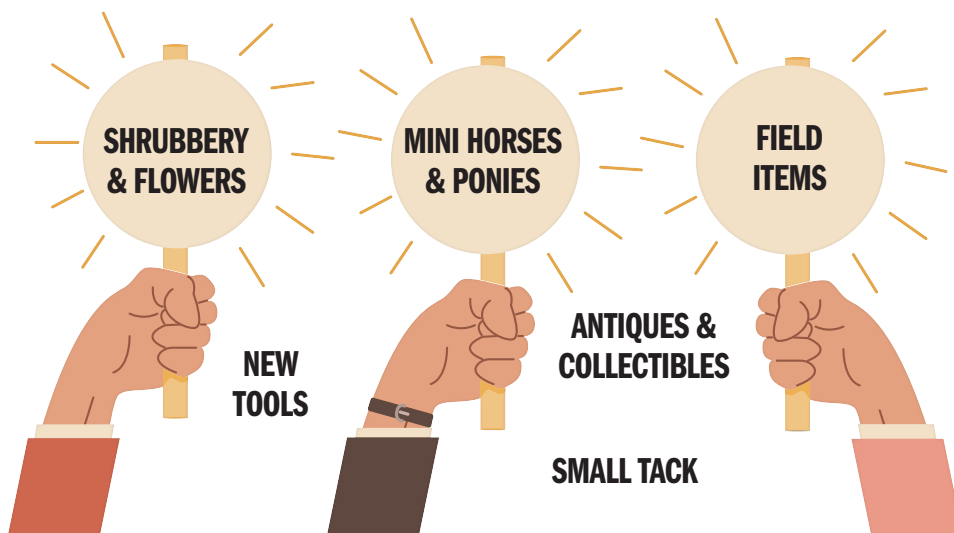

CONSIGNING PROCESS

Simply pull up the week of the auction during our drop-off days. Our team will make the process easy for you!

Consignment drop-off days:

Tuesday 6/23 8am-4pm

Wednesday 6/24 8am-8pm

Thursday 6/25 8am-12pm (no items after noon)

Arrive on-site with your items and check-in at the office. Our team will take a quick inventory and direct you to specialized category crews based on what you are selling (auction blocks). Staff members will help you unload your wares and display your goods. Your items may be registered as a lot or by piece. Consignors will receive copies of their items and lots numbers. All items must be in good, working condition unless antique. Please no appliances or farm equipment unless they are antique quality. On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, there will be 24-hour security on site.

HAULING, STORING, & DROPPING OFF YOUR ITEMS

We cannot store your items prior to the auction drop-off dates. Items dropped off during the week of the auction will be sorted, displayed, and cared for.

GETTING PAID

All auction items are sold on a consignment model, meaning that you take home a cut of the sale, and a portion is also donated to the Hand-in-Hand Fire Company.

After the auction, consignors will receive payment via check that will be mailed within one week of the event. Any unsold items can be picked up directly following the auction or left for donation.



MAKE A DONATION

Your unwanted items donated to our sale generates 100% profit for the Fire Company!

Simply drop off your items during the listed consignment drop-off dates and let our team know that you are making a donation. Receipts for items over \$250 may be requested.

No junk, appliances, or farm equipment except antique & primitive items like old hay wagons, walking plows, etc.

FAQ

What is a consignment auction?

A consignment auction features sellers who consign their products to an auction house (in this case the seller is Hand-in-Hand Fire Co). The seller can either be an individual or a business. The Fire Co. then acts as the third party and auctions off the items for the seller. In exchange, the Fire Co. receives a portion of the proceeds (see Commission Schedule) and the seller receives the rest.

Do I have to consign my items early?

Not anymore. As of 2026, we are not handling early consignments. All items will be processed during auction week! You just show up during sale week drop-off days with your items! We will update our website daily during sale week to show potential visitors what's for sale!

Do you accept donations?

Yes! Gather a few friends to collaborate on a homemade project such as a quilt, piece of furniture, a gift basket, or something else. Or, pull together some business associates and donate a high value item for our noon specialty sale. We will recognize your businesses in our flyer and on the auction block.

TERMS

Cash (US Funds only), money orders, checks. Credit cards accepted. All checks must be accompanied by a current bank letter of credit or be given prior approval by one of the committee members. **Auction committee is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or theft that may occur on auction grounds.**

1. This is not an absolute auction.
2. Cash/check/credit card settlement on day of sale. Visa/Mastercard/Discover are accepted, **subject to 3% processing fee.** All checks must be accompanied by a bank letter of credit or be given prior approval by a Sale Committee Member.
3. No sales tax or buyers premiums.
4. Unsettled accounts will be turned over to a bill collector.
5. Owner has 2 days to remove merchandise from Sale Grounds, after which (unless other arrangements are made) the Sale Committee will dispose of items as seen fit.
6. The Sale Grounds are closed on Sunday.
7. Sale Committee is not responsible for the condition of any item sold. Please inspect your items before purchasing.
8. Sale Committee is not responsible for any accidents, injuries or thefts that may occur on the Sale Grounds.
9. Items resold privately will be subject to a commission fee.

Even though the distance is only a quarter of a mile and easily walkable, the wagon ride is fun for children. The adults appreciate the convenience, especially in the afternoon when riders bring their auction purchases with them. Whenever possible, the wagon delivers people and goods right to their vehicles.

Plenty of parking is available in the fields adjacent to the auction grounds. Fire police will direct you.

HELP US BE GOOD NEIGHBORS!

Do NOT park at the Bird-in-Hand Farmer's Market or other businesses.

SECURITY / CHECKOUT

For your convenience, a secure area for checking parcels and large items is located in the center of the auction grounds. This service is available to you for several hours as you continue to bid.

BIDDER NUMBER AND/OR TICKET STUBS ARE REQUIRED TO RETRIEVE YOUR ITEMS FROM THE ROUND PEN.

EXIT SECURITY / CHECKOUT

When exiting the sale grounds, be prepared to show proof of purchase to security personnel by:

1. Showing your personal BIDDER CARD. That number should MATCH the red number on the item tag. *OR*
2. Showing the TICKET STUB, which should match the item purchased.

WAIT TIME

Please expect up to a 30 minute wait after purchasing items before attempting to pay for them. Our clerks work as quickly as possible. Thanks for your cooperation.

LOADING TIMES

There will be staff available to help. We have lifts available for heavy items. Small off road equipment to assist in transporting goods will be available, along with extra hands! No vehicle traffic is permitted through the auction complex before 3:00 pm Friday. Items may still be loaded during this time, but please do not disrupt the auction.
